EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Excellence in Motion

The year 2024–25 marked a pivotal chapter in the growth of Anjuman-I-Islam's Kalsekar Technical Campus, where academic distinction, institutional recognition, and societal contribution came together in harmony. AIKTC established in 2011, and has evolved into a dynamic academic ecosystem, offering Engineering, Pharmacy, Architecture, and allied programs with a sprawling 10.58-acre campus, having 143 committed faculty members, and 134 dedicated support staff, the institution continues to set benchmarks in quality technical education for the Mumbai Metropolitan Region and beyond.

Autonomy and Academic Empowerment

A historic milestone was reached when the University Grants Commission(UGC),New Delhi granted autonomous status to the School of Pharmacy and the School of Engineering & Technology for 2025–2030. This academic autonomy, coupled with the renewal of NAAC accreditation at B++ grade with a CGPA of 2.92, empowers AIKTC to craft innovative curricula and introduce cutting-edge programs, such as the new M.Tech in Computer Engineering and the expanded intake in AI & ML specializations. These developments reaffirm our commitment to staying ahead of industry trends and shaping future-ready graduates.

Innovation at the Core

AIKTC's research and innovation culture reached new heights this year, producing 27 international publications and 39 scholarly outputs including patents and books.
